FEATURES OF THE SCHOOL

ALMANAC

Student Almanac is an effective tool for student, teacher and parent for keeping information for a long time. 'Student Almanac' is a bridge for connecting among student, class teacher, subject teacher, school and parents. Students should bring this Almanac to school every day, use it productively and treat it with care. Parents should review current pages daily and must countersign and respond to any comments, which may be made periodically by members of the faculty. Parents should also countersign home assignments to signify their completion and provide an explanation if home assignments are not completed for any reason. Students will get home tasks on subjects. These tasks are intended as revision exercises, to reinforce what is learnt by students in school and must be undertaken by students entirely on their own, without adult supervision. Students should seek the help of their teachers at School on the following day if they encounter any difficulty. Comments made by parents in the Almanac should be productive and confined strictly to the subject of the student's work and her/his conduct. All other matters concerning the School should be dealt separately and either conveyed personally or through separate letters to the Principal.

ACADEMICS

Education is a systematic process through which a child or an adult acquires knowledge, experience, skill and sound attitude. **Aaryans Public School** will be engaged in the following features for over all development of each child.

- Individual attention and guidance to the student.
- Supervised Study in the school.
- Modern teaching system and methods.
- Inculcation of General Knowledge, AI, Aptitude and Moral Values.
- Regular Parent–Teacher meeting. Other than Parents Teachers Meeting, Medium of Mass Messaging system has been adopted to send intimation to the Parents for emergency notification, if any.
- **AARYANS** will continuously draw upon contemporary educational development, while retaining its emphasis on India's history, culture, art and tradition and conscientiously expose students to the best of both.

ASSEMBLY

To inculcate a high sense of National Integrity and Universal Brotherhood, each working day in the school starts with Yoga/ M.D followed by morning assembly. Special Assemblies on special days & festival celebration are important features of the assembly. During assemblies children's birthdays are celebrated and enlighten their little hearts with teachers and students.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

- School organizes Craft Exhibition, Sports Day, Teacher's Day, Annual Day and Annual Exhibition apart from many other functions. Children participate actively during these functions. Development of hobbies and practices of self help and Humanitarian Services.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

School gives lots of opportunities for self- expression and advancement of the culture heritage. Every child gets the opportunity to participate in every cultural event.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

It is imparted to the students by Mass P.T./drill and providing facilities of outdoor and indoor games to encourage healthy sportsman character, building sound body and healthy competitive spirit among the students.

PARENTS-TEACHERS MEETING

Parents can meet teachers personally on any 1st, 3rd & 4th Saturday from 10:30 am to 03:00 pm to discuss about your child's progress or any other information.

Parents will not be allowed to meet the teachers during school hours as their presence is more essential with children.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

To obtain highest levels of educational standard on the part of the students and parents.

Aaryans Public school expects you to observe the following norms:

SCHOOL SCHEDULE:

- Student should be in the school before 5 minutes of the school scheduled time, so that all the students will be present for assembly in time.
- Parents are requested to see that their children attend school punctually. Students waiting to be picked up after school hours should wait in the school's waiting area near the reception.
- Under no circumstances children should be left outside the school premises by the parents.

SECURITY & SAFETY:

- Parents should hand over their child to the watchman or entrust the child to the peon or teachers and are not left out of the school premises.
- If a student has to leave the school during the school hours, he/she should be accompanied by parent or guardian who must report to the school office. In case of a student's illness during school hours, the school will contact the concerned parent by the telephone number listed on the "Emergency Contact Card". If the nature of the emergency requires immediate medical attention, the Principal or the teacher will call the Emergency Medical Service. If there are any changes on the Emergency Contact Card the parents or a guardian is responsible to notify the same to the school in writing immediately.

ATTENDANCE

- Regularity of attendance and punctuality are important in the academic progress of the child and in His or Her character training.
- Children, who will be absent or late, should have the reason for this irregularity entered on record pages of the Almanac. Absenteeism of any nature should be communicated to the class teacher as soon as possible.
- Retaining the child from school for an extra vacation during school time should be given very serious consideration by the parents.
- A written excuse from the parent of an absent student must be presented to the teacher when the student returns to the school. These rules are a part of the attendance file. The perforated school leave letters are in the Almanac.
- A student, returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, should produce a doctor's fitness certificate permitting her/him to attend school. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to school. However, the exact period of quarantine will depend upon the severity of the infection which should be confirmed by a certified medical practitioner.
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- *Chicken Pox Till the scabs fall completely Not more than 15 days
- *Cholera Till the child has completely recovered Not more than 15 Days
- *Measles Two weeks after the rash disappears Not more than 15 Days
- *Mumps Until the swelling has gone Not more than 15 Days
- *Whooping Cough Till the doctor certifies Not more than 20 Days
- * Hepatitis Till the doctor certifies Not more than 20 Days
- * Swine Flu Till the doctor certifies Not more than 15 Days

DRESS CODE

- Student should arrive at school with a clean uniform.
- Blow out, jells, no fancy hair styles and hair colours are not allowed. Nail polish, makeup should not be used during the school.
- Girls with simple hairstyle. Boy's hair length may not extend collar length. Hair should be combed neatly. Girl should not wear bangles, long earrings, flowers or any accessories to the school.

SCHOOL BOOKS AND REPORTS:

- Books should be handled with care and kept neat & clean by the student.
- Books have to be sent to school only in accordance with the time table.

TRANSFERS:

- If a student is to be transferred to another school, the school must be notified at least four months prior to the transfer. A parent or legal guardian must sign an official Withdrawal Form in the school office.

FINANCES:

- School Fees should be paid in FULL. Fee defaulters will not be allowed to continue. No refund/ return of fees will be done, once paid.

CHILDCARE:

- Toys, mobile phones, comics and any other electronic devices should not be brought to school. Students are not permitted to exchange toys, books, pencils etc.
- Chewing gum should never be brought to school.
- Students should not carry money or chips or chocolates to the school.

DISCIPLINE:

- Students are expected at all times to behave obediently and respectfully towards the teachers and other staff members in the school. They are to show gentleness and courtesy towards their classmates. Screaming and noisy behaviour is not allowed.
- Discipline is the training that develops self-control, orderliness, efficiency and character. Basic to all discipline is the principle of respect, respect for parents, teachers, one's self and others and for all children.
- Parents are expected to co-operate with the school by enforcing self-control and discipline by maintaining a positive encouragement to their child's academic progress.
- Bullying and the use of foul language are punishable offences, whether in or out of the school.
- Damaging or disfiguring any school property may result in expulsion from the school for a month.
- In addition to Students are expected to carry books and notebooks in strict accordance with the time table and refrain from bringing unnecessary material to school.
- Students are strictly prohibited from commuting to school on cycles (student will be allowed only if they reside at a distance of half a kilometre) or self-driven two/four-wheelers.

HEALTH CHECK UP

Student Health Check-up In addition to fostering academic success, school plays a vital role in improving students' health and social etiquette. The Doctors will identify any health-related issues and to generate awareness on the importance of health and personal hygiene.

HOUSE SYSTEM

All the students are divided into four houses Agni- Red , Jal- Blue, Vayu- Yellow. Prithvi- Green . This inculcates a spirit of healthy competition and leadership in them. Each house is headed by a student captain. A member of the staff, assisted by other teachers. Points are awarded to students throughout the year for all co / extra-curricular activities, academics, discipline, and sports. At the end of the year, the two houses with the highest number of points are awarded rolling trophies. Inter-house competitions are organized in sports, dramatics, debates, quiz, art, music, dance and environment-based themes.

GRADE I-IX

The academic year is divided into two terms. Students are evaluated through formal assessments as well as through their day to day performance.

Four formal assessments are conducted in the academic session, twice during each term:

*Pre Mid-Term Assessment (PT1) is formative in nature includes the entire syllabus covered in Term-1 till the test date.

*Mid-Term Assessment (MT) is cumulative in nature and includes the entire syllabus of Term-1.

* Post Mid-Term Assessment (PT2) is formative in nature and includes the syllabus covered in Term-2 till the test date.

*Annual Examination(AE) is cumulative in nature and is based on selected portion from Term-1 and the entire syllabus of Term-2.

* Pre and Post Mid-Term Assessments (PT1 and PT2) written test. Continuous evaluation is carried out throughout the session in various ways which include written work done in school and at home, verbal assessments via classroom discussions and interactions, project assignments and co-curricular activities. The final grades of all examinable subjects in a term will take into account the performance of student in both the continuous and the written assessments.

School Awards

Student should have at least 90% attendance to be eligible for any School award.

Academic Awards On the basis of the student's performance in assessments/assignments and examination, the following awards or certificates will be bestowed:

Proficiency Certificates: Will be awarded subject wise to the student who has secured 95% and above in individual subjects in all the term assessments and more than 90% attendance in the session. Badge of Distinction Students with 100% attendance will be awarded with a Badge.
